



SFY 2021 STATE GENERAL REVENUE FUND & FEDERAL AWARD PROJECT LISTING- Specialized Transportation Program (Section 5310) & Mobility Management

PROGRAM: SFY 2021 Specialized Transportation Program

PROGRAM PURPOSE: To enhance the mobility of seniors and individuals with disabilities by removing barriers to transportation services and expanding the transportation services, planned designed, and carried out to meet the special transportation needs of seniors and individuals with disabilities.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS: Private nonprofit organizations; state or local government authority that has been approved by a state to coordinated services for seniors and individuals with disabilities.

APPLICATION PROCESS: Applications are received annually from rural and small urban agencies to the ODOT Office of Transit. Applicants projects are then reviewed using the following three phases: Form Completeness Check, Project Completeness Check and Application Scoring. During the scoring process, projects are scored based on scoring criteria in place for each eligible project under the Section 5310 Program. Eligible projects include: Vehicles, Computer Hardware/ or software, Mobility Management, Preventive Maintenance, and Operating Assistance.

PROGRAM: SFY 2021 Ohio Mobility Management Program

PROGRAM PURPOSE: Mobility Management Projects are capital projects that increase access to mobility for Ohioans by increasing understanding and awareness of transportation needs, promote coordination of transportation options to meet needs, and build sustainable and healthy communities by integrating transportation into planning and programs.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS: All Ohio Mobility Management Projects are funded by the Specialized Transportation (Section 5310) Program or the Rural Transit Program (Section 5311). All sub recipients must be 5310 & 5311 eligible entities. Eligible entities include Private Non-Profit Organizations and State or Local Government authorities that are approved by state to coordinate services for older adults and individuals with disabilities and certifies that there are no nonprofit organizations readily available in the area to provide the services'

APPLICATION PROCESS: Applications are submitted annually and are scored by ODOT – Office of Transit. Final Project Selection will be made by the Program Coordinator and the Public Transit Manager. ODOT awards projects based on application score.
